Yolo County Law Library Board of Trustees Minutes of the June 29, 2023 Meeting

The Yolo County Law Library Board of Trustees held a meeting on Thursday, May 25, 2023, scheduled for 12:15 PM, at the Yolo County Law Library, 204 4th Street, Suite A, Woodland, CA 95695.

President Wolk called the meeting to order at 12:18 PM. **Present:** Trustees Colon, Cortés, Harvey, Mack, Welton, Wolk. Staff: Director Coles. Visitor: Pete Rooney, Sacramento County Public Law Library **Absent:** Trustee Meyer

There was no public attendance, and no public comment was received.

Discussion and action items:

- **1) Consider approval of routine business.** The minutes of the May 25, 2023 meeting were approved.
- 2) Financial report.
 - a. Court distributions for April 2023 were reported (\$10,381.36).
 - b. An income and expenditure report for FY2023 to date was provided.
- **3)** Potential administrative relationship with Sacramento County Public Law Library. Coles and Rooney proposed to the Board that it put off making a decision about hiring a new director until its September meeting, to give them time to put together a plan for Sacramento to run the Yolo County Law Library. Coles stated that she had agreed to remain on board through December 2023, which would still give the Board three months to hire a new director should it decide to do so in September. Coles also said she could devote some time after December to provide assistance and training to whoever will run the library after that point. The Board agreed to postpone its decision until September.
- **4) FY2024 budget.** Coles provided the Board with a proposed budget for FY2024. She stated that the county law libraries were not included in the recently passed FY24 state budget, but that there was a small possibility that there could be an additional appropriation after October, when the state expects more tax revenue from extended deadlines.

Coles reported on the year-end status of the FY2023 budget, noting that total filing fee receipts for the year would not come in until August. Her estimate, given total

estimated receipts and expenditures, was that the Law Library would have around \$54,615 in unspent funds for the fiscal year.

The FY2024 proposed budget included about \$13,000 in spending beyond the library's routine expenditures for salaries, insurance, IT, janitorial, and office expenses (copier lease, paper, supplies, etc.). With these expenditures, Coles predicted an overall shortfall of around \$14,000 for FY2024 but said that the Board could dedicate \$14,000 in unspent funds from FY23 to the FY24 budget and still add around \$40,000 to its general reserves, leaving the Law Library with nearly \$300,000 in reserve funds.

Coles said the Board would vote on the budget at its next meeting, and that the budget could also be amended if needed at any point during the fiscal year. The Board expressed no concern about the proposed plan.

- 5) Director's report. Coles reported that the county had reluctantly agreed to cover the front yard cleanup expenditures but said that the Library would be responsible for all maintenance costs going forward.
- 6) Next meeting. It was stated that the next Board of Trustees meeting would be on Thursday, July 27, 2023, at 12:15 PM, at the Yolo County Law Library.
- 7) Adjournment. The meeting was adjourned at 1:00 PM.

The closed session was not held due to the Board's decision under item 3 above.

YOLO COUNTY LAW LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES RESOLUTION NO. 24-1

RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH AN INDEPENDENT LAW LIBRARY BANK ACCOUNT

WHEREAS, the Yolo County Law Library (YCLL) is committed to efficient and effective management of its financial accounts for the purpose of funding resources and activities for its patrons as approved by the Board;

WHEREAS, YCLL frequently requires the ability to use a credit card to purchase needed goods and services;

WHEREAS, YCLL cannot obtain a credit card through its current treasurer, Yolo County, and does not qualify on its own for the state CAL-Card program;

WHEREAS, state law (Business and Professions Code 6326) allows the Board by resolution to establish a revolving fund in a commercial bank account of not more than \$50,000 from money in the law library fund;

WHEREAS, having a commercial bank account would enable the Law Library to obtain a credit card;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Yolo County Law Library Board of Trustees as follows:

- 1. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.
- The Law Library is authorized to establish a revolving fund in a commercial bank account in the amount of \$50,000, obtain a credit card, and use the account and credit card subject to procedures approved by the Board for purchasing and replenishing funds.
- 3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

Business and Professions Code 6326. A revolving fund of not more than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) may be established from money in the law library fund, by resolution of the board of law library trustees, for expenditures of not exceeding ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) each for purposes for which the law library fund may lawfully be expended. The board shall prescribe the procedure by which money may be drawn from the revolving fund, the records to be kept, and the manner in which reimbursements shall be made to the revolving fund by demand and order from the law library fund. All or any part of the money in the revolving fund may be deposited in a commercial account in a bank, subject to payments of not exceeding ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) each by check on the signature of the secretary or any other person or persons designated by the board.
